Production Alert: Fred C. Nelles Facility Reopens for Filming
New Scouting Procedures

The vacant Fred C. Nelles Correctional Facility has reopened for filming after a year long closure. Now operated by the California Department of Corrections and Rehabilitation (CDCR), new filming and scouting procedures are in place.

Location Tours of the Facility

There is now a fee of \$250.00 for all facility tours/scouts. Scouting tours of the facility can be arranged for Wednesdays from 9 am – 1 pm. The tours can accommodate 4 different production companies at once with no limit to the number of people per company.

In order to schedule a tour you must complete a Buildings and Facilities film application at www.dot.ca.gov/cfc.

Applications for scouting must be submitted at least 4 business days prior to the scout date. There are no exceptions to this process.

Within the application under the *Location* tab please press Add Location. When filling out an application, insert the scouting date in the shoot date field.

The location name is: Fred C. Nelles Youth Facility.

Under the Activity section please type in *Location Scout only*.

Then follow the prompts to review and submit the application to the CFC.

Payment for the scout must be delivered to the California Film Commission before the scout date or paid directly at Fred C. Nelles Youth Correction Facility the day of the tour. If no payment is received you will not be allowed access to the property.

The State can only accept payment via check (personal, business, cashier or money order). Please make checks payable to: CA Department of Corrections and Rehabilitation or CDCR in the amount of \$250.00.
